## GCSE POST-RESULTS INFORMATION LEAFLET 2026/26

If you are considering a review of results, we recommend that you request **Access to Scripts** at **least two weeks** prior to the Review of Results deadline.

**Late applications will not be accepted by the awarding bodies.**

<b>Access to Scripts</b> (for deciding on whether to request Review of Results)	<b>End of day 14 September 2026</b>
<b>Service 1</b> – clerical re-check This is a check of all the clerical procedures leading to the issue of a result.  The service will include:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• That all parts of the script have been marked</li><li>• The totalling of the marks</li><li>• The recording of the marks.</li></ul> <b>The outcome of the re-check will be reported along with a statement of the total marks awarded for each unit, or component included in the enquiry.</b>	<b>End of day 21 September 2026</b>
<b>Service 2</b> – Review of Marking  Will include clerical re-checks as per Service 1, and a review of results to ensure that the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly. It is not a re-marking of the candidate's script. You can request a copy of the reviewed script at the same time if you wish, for a further fee.	<b>End of day 21 September 2026</b>  <b>If you wish to see your reviewed paper and see any review changes you MUST PAY AND REQUEST A COPY OF THE REVIEWED SCRIPT AT THE SAME TIME.</b>
<b>Access to Scripts</b> (just for your information, <u>without</u> a follow-up Review of Results)	<b>End of day 21 September 2026</b>

If you would like to receive a copy of your script or request a Review of Marking, you will need to send us a signed consent form.

The forms are available on the City Lit Help Centre, at the bottom of the *Post results information for GCE and GCSE exams* page. We cannot download your script or request a review without your written permission.

If you request Review of Marking, please note that **there is no grade protection**.

This means that your marks and subject grades may be lowered, confirmed or raised as a result.

Where there has been a reduction in marks or a downgrade following a review of marking, the request cannot be revoked, and the original mark or grade will not be reinstated.
